Rapid APP coverage supports trauma and surgical care

Challenge

One of Michigan's largest hospitals, Corewell Health William Beaumont University Hospital (WBUH), faced critical gaps in APP coverage due to unexpected staffing shortages.

The shortages threatened continuity of care for the facility's trauma and surgical patients. The hospital needed a fast and fully credentialed solution to maintain safe staffing levels and patient care standards.
